NOTIFICATION OF AQUATIC TREATMENT Lost Lake & Knops Pond Groton

SOLitude Lake Management, 590 Lake Street, Shrewsbury, MA 01545, Telephone (508) 865-1000, has been contracted by the Town of Groton to chemically treat Lost Lake & Knops Pond in Groton for control of the non-native invasive weeds fanwort and milfoil. Portions of each water body will be treated with the USEPA/State registered herbicides Reward (diquat) and Sonar (fluridone). The application is scheduled for Tuesday, June 7th, 2016. This treatment will be performed in accordance with a permit issued by the Massachusetts DEP.

The following temporary water use restrictions will be imposed in treated and posted areas:

- No swimming on the day of treatment
- Do not use treated lake water for drinking for 3 days, for irrigation purposes for 5 days and for watering livestock for 1 day.
- Additionally, in the Springy Cove area, do not use treated water for irrigation purposes for 90 days.

The shoreline of areas to be treated in Lost Lake and Knops Pond will be posted with signs warning of the temporary water use restrictions that will be imposed, immediately prior to each treatment.
